

ANNEX 2B - Financial Report 2022-2023 Annual General Meeting, October 19, 2023 to determine

The Executive Committee hereby presents you with the financial report for the year 2022-2023 (Annex 2B), the anticipated budget 2023-2024 (Annex 2F) and the financial forecast 2024-2025 (Annex 2G).

The Treasurer and the Secretariat have enlisted the financial expertise of Finovion, an umbrella organization for administration offices in the Netherlands to ensure that the balance is made according to the appropriate standards.

The format of this Financial Report is according to the standards of Finovion.

Decision

To approve the financial report 2022-2023 and to grant discharge to the Daily Board.



Clarifications on the Financial Report 2022-2023

The financial year 2022-2023 runs from May 1, 2022, to April 30, 2023

General

In preparing the financial statement, the GPM annual term closes with a profit of €9,711.

Compared to the profit of the previous financial year (€55,877), the profit of 2022/2023 has substantially decreased. This is because a significant grant of the British Council ended in the previous financial year. The income in the financial year 2022- 2023 came solely from the membership fees and the contribution from the City of The Hague for the position of the Executive Director and the location of the GPM Secretariat at the city hall of The Hague.

The 2022-2023 budget was decided upon during the Annual General Meeting on October 6, 2022. The budget was based on an expected membership of 62 by 30 April 2023. Over the course of the financial year, the GPM welcomed 14 new members. Five members have left the GPM, due to overdue membership fee or changed leadership. Between May 2022 and April 2023, the GPM received the membership fees of 45 members.

In June 2023, the GPM created the 'associated partnership' as an additional paid arrangement for associations of mayors or cities to join the GPM. An associated partner can delegate maximum two mayors to participate in the GPM. In December 2023, the Sicilian branch of ANCI, the National Association of Italian Cities, joined the GPM as the first associated partner.

In 2022, the GPM also established the candidate-membership to introduce mayors to the GPM who distinguish themselves with outstanding leadership, but have limited budgets. In 2022-2023, the GPM counted four candidate members.

In June 2022, Mayor Marcin Krupa of Katowice, Poland, hosted the GPM Annual Summit with the title: "Transforming Together: How Cities Must Lead Democratic, Inclusive, and Innovative Global Change". The Annual Summit took place prior to the World Urban Forum which was also hosted by the mayor of Katowice. Over 45 mayors representing 20 countries participated in the mayoral debates of the GPM Summit, along with leaders of city networks, and representatives of international organizations, including representatives from UN Habitat, OECD, Welcoming International, Chicago Council on Global Affairs and Peace in Our Cities.

In 2022, the GPM, together with the German Marshal Fund and the Pact of Free Cities, developed the Global Declaration of Mayors for Democracy. This initiative emanated from the partnership of the GPM and the GMF in the US Summit for Democracy hosted by the Biden Administration in December 2021, and the Pact of Free Cities which was established in 2019. Early 2023, the Declaration, signed by over 250 mayors worldwide, was presented at the second US Summit. The Global Declaration for Democracy and the opportunity to participate in the US Summit for Democracy, substantially increased the visibility of the GPM and created new contacts with mayors and opportunities to cooperate with international organizations.

Over the course of the financial year 2022-2023, the GPM, as partner of the G7 Urban7 Group, had the unique opportunity to make the voice of cities heard in the G7 process. In September 2022, the GPM Chair joined the first-ever G7 ministerial meeting for Sustainable Urban Development on behalf of the U7. The participation of the GPM at this ministerial level was a remarkable sign of progress towards the goal of the GPM of fostering multi-level governance and the GPM's vision of a future in which mayors are equal partners in building global governance for an inclusive and sustainable world.

From January 2023 onwards, the GPM, together with ICLEI, will host the U7 Secretariat as a permanent support of future U7 activities.

In 2022-2023, the city of Mannheim has reached out to the German government for structural financial support of the GPM in 2023-2025. Through Engagement Global and their Service Agency Community in One World, the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development has agreed to finance the position of the GPM Executive Director from September 1, 2023 until August 31, 2025.

Substantive remarks

Income from memberships

On 1 May 2023, the GPM counted 45 paying members with an average fee of €2,900. In the 2022-2023 budget, the number of members was set at 62 members to finance the organization.

A point of attention is the timely payment of membership fees. In particular in connection with the number of members that are still below the set goal and the associated lower income from membership fees. On 1 May 2023, the total amount of unpaid membership fees 2022-2023 was €33,367. Additionally, the outstanding membership fees of previous years on 1 May 2023, was €52,159.

Other income

Since the founding of the GPM in 2016, the City of The Hague has hosted the GPM Secretariat and partly covered the costs of the Secretariat team. In 2022-2023, The Hague has continued to cover the office space of the Secretariat office (€28,000) and the full-time position of the Executive Director (€80,000).

Personnel costs

The GPM has been responsible for ensuring the personnel costs of a part-time senior programme officer at the GPM Secretariat, a part-time junior program officer trainee (0,5), a part-time communication officer (0,4) between May-December 2022, and a full time intern between May-July 2022 and March-April 2023.

General reserves

This year, the profit of the positive balance (€9,711) will be added back to the obligatory financial reserves. On 30 April 2023, the Equity of capital amounts to €78,444.
